# **Preparing your Will**

It is essential to seek legal advice when making your Will. Should you wish to support Ballarat Hospice Care with a gift in your will, the appropriate wording is as follows:

"I bequeath to Ballarat Hospice Care Inc. 1836 Sturt Street, Alfredton, VIC 3350 free from all duties for its sole use and benefit the sum of \$....... OR ....% of the residue, OR the whole residue of my Estate. The receipt of Ballarat Hospice Care Inc. shall be full and sufficient discharge to my executors for the payment of this bequest."
