Space for hire

Our conference and meeting rooms are bright, calm, warm and welcoming with integrated, user friendly audio visual and wireless internet.

Room hire includes:

- tables and seating
- large screen TV, camera and speakers (in the meeting rooms)
- Wi-Fi internet access
- access to kitchen facilities for tea and coffee making
- access to the room prior to the event for room set up
- tea and coffee for up to 20 people (for 20+ people an additional fee is charged).

Hirers will arrange the room to their requirements and will organise their own catering.
